Chapter 7 - Human Resources

BP 7600 POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Board has established a police department under the supervision of one Chief of Police who shall report directly to the Vice Chancellor of Facilities Management. The primary purpose of the department is to enforce the law on or near the campuses and other grounds or properties owned, operated, controlled or administered by the District.

District police officers shall be employed as members of the classified service but shall, when duly sworn, be peace officers as defined by law. Prior to employment, they shall satisfy the training requirements set out in Penal Code Sections 830, et seq.

The Chancellor shall establish minimum qualifications of employment for the Chief of Police including, but not limited to, prior employment as a peace officer or completion of a peace officer training course approved by the Commission on Peace Officers' Standards and Training.

Every member of the police department shall be issued a suitable identification card and badge.

The Chancellor shall assure that the Vice Chancellor of Facilities Management and the Chief of Police issue such other regulations as may be necessary for the administration of the police department.
