Chancellor Carroll commented that a new bill, AB 3015 (Benoit), has passed out of the Assembly Higher Education Committee. This bill includes the "equalization compromise proposal" for \$161 million, and both the Underfunded Districts' Caucus and the San Diego Community College District are supporting it. She also noted that Senator Denise Ducheny has authored a bill, SB 1290, that would align community colleges with UC and CSU in construction standards, instead of the more costly K-12 Field Act requirements.

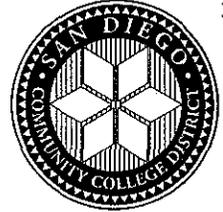

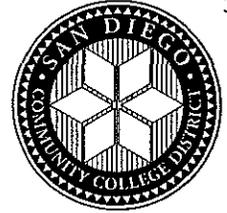

180 REPORT OF THE CHANCELLOR

Chancellor Carroll reported on the recent national conference of the American Association of Community Colleges (AACC) and was pleased to report that our District was well represented. She acknowledged Larry Fitch, President of the Workforce Partnership, who participated in one of the presentations about the BIOCUM/BIOTECH Program.

The Chancellor also commented on the developing state budget for 2006-2007 and shared information from a recently released report indicating that state revenue is at an all time high. California tax collectors have already received \$1.5 billion more than the \$8.2 billion projected in the Governor's January budget proposal. It is hoped that this increase and other additional revenue will make it easier to resolve the differences between the Governor and Legislature.
