Mesa College President Rita Cepeda and Miramar President Patricia Hsieh also attended. The meeting was an opportunity for the Governor to present his vision for CTE, as put forth in his proposed \$52 million initiative, and to receive comments from the field. initiative calls for a closer collaboration between community colleges and high schools to increase the number of young people entering the workforce in various fields.
