Vice Chancellor Dave Umstot stated that the proposal to charge a parking fee for weekend events is complex and will involve discussions with the campuses for future consideration; however, that will take time since there may be Civic Center Act issues involved. Parking Program Supervisor Debra Picou stated that the cap for parking permit fees is \$20 for Financial Aid students, so they will not be affected by this proposed change.
