Chancellor Carroll

- 1. Chancellor Carroll reported on the status of the State budget, noting that because of the continually changing budget scenario for 2010-2011, District leadership was awaiting the Governor's May Revision budget, which is the next important step in the budget process. Following the May Revision budget, districtwide advocacy efforts will be needed to support beneficial items and oppose items that would be harmful to community colleges.
- 2. She also reported that a letter supporting SB 1440 (Padilla), which would standardize transfer agreements with the California State University system, was sent today to state Senator Christine Kehoe, who chairs the Senate Appropriations Committee. She also indicated that, at the request of Trustee Maria Nieto Senour, an additional letter, signed by all Board members, would be sent to support this legislation.
