The Corona virus or COVID-19 is a fluctuating situation, and as you know, many college districts and universities are closing temporarily or moving instruction into a temporary remote learning environment.

Beginning Monday, March 16, and for at least two weeks, some campuses within the San Diego Community College District (SDCCD) will begin transitioning classes to remote instruction on a temporary basis.
