\***All** new course, substantial course revisions, new programs, and program revisions must be approved by CIC, Board of Trustees, and the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO); new programs are subject to Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges/Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACCJC/WASC) before they may be published.

**Note:** *New Career Technical Education (CTE) programs require Labor Market Information prior to Board of Trustees approval, and Regional Workforce Development Council approval prior to CCCCCO approval.*

Vice Presidents of Instruction may request exceptions to the curriculum deadlines for critical curriculum (i.e. C-ID approval, loss of accreditation from an outside agency, loss of articulation, state established deadline, student success, or workforce training), pending District Curriculum Services approval prior to the curriculum being presented at CIC.
