New Agreement Development

Discussions are underway for the following agreement(s):

- Mesa College
 - EXSC 242B (working on approved final assessment)
 - Fall 2022, credit college faculty confirmed course alignment, there were delays in confirming the final assessment; a revised assessment is being considered.
 - MATH 119 (on hold)
 - Fall 2022, exploration was initiated after Math faculty had met independently with San Diego Unified. Spring 2022, course alignment and final assessment were approved - the high school

course is UC approved curriculum. Agreement was distributed for signature and then put on hold due to the UC email that came out

- We have been told that the UC email was incorrect and a new formal email will be distributed clarifying that our high school and noncredit agreements for credit by exam are allowable
- Mesa college waiting on recommendation from Articulation Officer(s)
- Unclear whether Mesa will move forward with this agreement or not
- TBD / Architecture Courses a pathway partnership meeting is being scheduled to increase credit college faculty awareness of SDUSD's courses work within their architecture related pathways and to discuss possible opportunities for agreement development. Original meeting was scheduled for the end of September, but SDUSD had to cancel – meeting is being re-scheduled for the spring.
- TBD/ Digital Marketing faculty and SDUSD partners expressed interest in possibly exploring an agreement tied to digital marketing. In early stages of discussion.

Important DCCE Updates for CTE Transitions Credit by Exam

SDCCE is working to improve the student experience and success within the SDCCE CTE Transitions Credit by Exam process. Student Processes and requirements have changed for fall 2022 enrollments.

Summary of Changes

- New Icon for increased visibility of opportunity to receive credit through credit by exam process has been added to the SDCCE online schedule
- Students no longer have to take the extra step to request college credit (pursuing an opt in model tied to enrollment in the noncredit course)
- Faculty no longer have to enter grades in the external Instructor Certification Process (grades will be entered into campus solutions)
- Increased support for completing the credit College Application (CCCApply) is available
- Student communication is being improved as is counselor training
