



# **EOPS Annual Report**

**2014-15**

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## Introduction

This report is intended to provide information regarding Extended Opportunity Programs and Services (EOPS) students and their course-taking behaviors. It is divided into two sections: 1) Student Demographics and 2) Student Outcomes. Where possible, the all student population is used as a comparison group. This report also includes benchmarks that may be used as a point of reference, including averages for the EOPS student population and all student population.

Data for this report were pulled from the SDCCD Information System. Enrolled students are measured in their courses as of official census unless otherwise noted. **Please note that college affiliation is determined by the college offering the EOPS service.** Where possible, outcomes are presented individually for each college and overall by all colleges. **Also note that students may take classes at multiple colleges; therefore, summed college totals may not match the all colleges total.** Additionally, some percentages may not total 100% due to rounding error.

Student demographics and certificate/degree information are provided by the 2014-15 academic year. Demographic data includes all students who were reported to MIS (Management Information Systems) and students who may not have been officially enrolled. Enrollment status and student outcomes are provided separately for each primary term (fall and spring) in the 2014-15 academic year. Course success and retention rates are calculated for Fall 2014 and Spring 2015 primary terms. Student term-to-term persistence is calculated using Fall 2013 students as the cohort persisting to the Spring 2014 term and annual persistence is calculated using Fall 2013 students persisting to Spring 2014 and Fall 2014.

Several of the measures used in this report warrant description.

- *Annual Persistence* - The percentage of census enrolled students in a fall term who received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD and who enrolled in at least one course in *both* the subsequent spring and fall terms and received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD.
- *Cumulative GPA* – Student cumulative GPA measured at the completion of each term.
- *Retention Rate* - The percentage of students who complete a course with a grade of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD out of total census enrollments. (Note: tutoring, non-credit positive attendance, and in-service are excluded).
- *Success Rate* - The percentage of students who complete a course with a grade of A, B, C, or P out of total census enrollments. (Note: tutoring, non-credit positive attendance, and in-service are excluded).
- *Term-to-Term Persistence* - The percentage of census enrolled students in a fall term who received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD (cohort) and who enrolled in at least one course in the subsequent spring term and received a grade notation of A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I or RD.
