
San Diego Community College District Transfers to San Diego State University Transfer Profile

The purpose of the profile is to show the demographic distributions of students who transferred to San Diego State University. The information is broken down by college and includes students who transferred to San Diego State Fall 1997, Fall 1998, or Fall 1999 and enrolled in more than one course at City, Mesa or Miramar during the 6 years prior to transfer. These demographics are based on each student's last semester at City, Mesa or Miramar before transferring to SDSU. Following are some key findings:

- The majority of students were under the age of 24 during their last semester before transfer.
- Most students stated "Transfer" as their educational objective on their application of admission to SDCCD. The next most common objective of students who transferred was "Undecided."
- More females than males transferred from City, Mesa, or Miramar to SDSU.
- More students transferred with 70 89.9 units of previous coursework completed.
- The majority of students had a transfer GPA of 2.5 − 2.99.
