You may be concerned about the possibility of a federal government shutdown and its impact upon you. The Board of Trustees, Chancellor, and College Presidents are committed to ensuring that you **receive** your financial aid on schedule so that you can continue attending classes without any disruption. Therefore, in the event of a government shutdown, the District will fund your financial aid so you will not be impacted.

The San Diego City, Mesa, and Miramar College Financial Aid Offices would like to provide you with the following important information.

The closure of the federal government (commonly referred to as a shutdown or furlough), will have minimal or no impact on students. If there is a federal government shutdown, students and parents will continue to be able to conduct business pertaining to financial aid as follows:

- Contact customer service centers;
- Complete and submit a FAFSA application;
- Request an FSA ID for electronic signature on documents related to the federal aid application process;
- Receive federal aid fund disbursements;
- Access student loan servicing, consolidation and debt collection systems websites; and
- Access the National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) student access website.
