Primary Election: June 7, 2016

Registration Deadlines: (online & mail-in)

- 15 days prior to Election Day (May 23, 2016)
 - Online = must be completed online by midnight
 - Mail-in = postmarked or hand-delivered at least 15 days prior to the election
