2.0 Payment Plans

- The Council discussed a preliminary business process for the new payment plan system that will be implemented for Spring 2020 registration.
- The Council recommended the following broad benchmarks for:
 - o Timeline windows should begin with the first day of registration.
 - o Initial payment should be required.
 - Final payment should be made before registration starts for next semester to avoid holds and interruption.

- Adrian Gonzales (Vice President, Student Services Miramar College) agreed to follow-up with Palomar College on their timelines.
- 3.0 Assessment/Placement Business Process for Foreign High School Students
 - The Council reviewed the new assessment/placement business process for students who graduated high school from outside of the United States.
 - The Council supported proceeding with the new business process.
- 4.0 Summer Course Limit for High School Students
 - The Council discussed the summer course load limit for high school students taking classes on the college campus. The following was agreed to:
 - Two classes
 - Petition for exceptions
- 5.0 Additional Degrees
 - AP 5025 Philosophy and Criteria for Associate Degrees and General Education
 - The Council reviewed changes to the Additional Degree language in AP 5025 and provided feedback and suggestions for Instructional Services regarding ADT exemptions.
 - o Lynn Neault will provide the suggested feedback to Instructional Services.
- 6.0 AB 705 Student Services Communication (Whisenhunt)
 - The Council discussed the need for a meeting to discuss AB 705 implementation with counselors and assessment staff. It was agreed that the matter has been resolved.

7.0 Campus Solutions Update

- The Council was provided with a status update on Campus Solutions. Lynn Neault provided an overview of the functions that students were having the most difficulty with including:
 - Password Self-Service.
 - Students are having difficulty remembering the passwords and security questions since the process is fairly clumsy.
 - The registration process is now a four step process; students are not completing the process.
 - Class schedule search is <u>not</u> intuitive; students are struggling finding classes.
 - Wait-listing is not working properly.
 - Adding classes is not intuitive. Tutorials and step-by-step guides to help students are being widely disseminated.
- Due to the interdependence of the various modules in the system, there is a need to begin to cross-train staff so they have a basic understanding of business processes in other departments. The training team will begin to schedule cross-training once fall settles down. There also needs to be a shift in how we serve students; rather than refer them to other offices/departments, frontline staff should have a basic understanding of core processes.

8.0 Other

- Canvas Issue
 - Kats Gustafson (Instructional Services Representative) reported on the issue with Canvas and drop students appearing on rosters. They are working to resolve the issue.
