

Campus Solutions Enrollment Process


Subject: Finish enrolling: Classes are in your shopping cart, but you are not enrolled.

Dear Student:

We noticed there are classes in your shopping cart and you are **not** enrolled. Please be aware that you must finish the enrollment process before you are officially registered in these classes.

Enrollment is a three part process:


ENROLLMENT: ADD CLASSES
