

## San Diego Community College District Petition for Excused Withdrawal

**Purpose of Petition:** To request academic excused withdrawal for circumstances reasonably beyond the control of the student that caused for them to be unable to attend classes or complete the semester/term. Circumstances include, but are not limited to: 1) medical emergency, including accident, serious illness, or non-elective surgery for themselves or a member of their immediate family; 2) personal emergency or hardship situation such as assault or domestic violence, loss of job or job transfer, family or child-care dependency crisis, or death of an immediate family member.

**Note:** It is recommended that students visit with a counselor to discuss alternative options to an Excused Withdrawal (EW) to be sure that this choice is the best course of action for the student's academic career. Additionally, students receiving financial aid should contact the Financial Aid Office to understand the possible implications.

## Petition for Excused Withdrawal Information

- Excused withdrawal will not be counted in progress probation and dismissal calculations.
- Excused withdrawal will not be counted as an enrollment attempt.
- No refunds will be provided for Excused Withdrawals.
- Excused withdrawals will not be accepted for classes completed prior to Spring 2018
