## Board of Trustees Policy

### Chapter 2 - Board of Trustees

#### BP 2745 BOARD SELF-EVALUATION

---

The Board of Trustees will conduct an annual evaluation of its accomplishments. The evaluation has two components. These are (1) the self-evaluation among Board members and (2) the periodic evaluation of Board members by faculty, administration, staff and other parties who are most knowledgeable of and involved in the Board's meetings and other functions.

A committee of the Board shall be appointed to determine the instrument or process to be used in board self-evaluation. Any evaluation instrument shall incorporate criteria contained in these board policies regarding board operations, as well as criteria defining board effectiveness promulgated by recognized practitioners in the field.

The process for evaluation shall be recommended to and approved by the Board.

If an instrument is used, all board members will be asked to complete the evaluation instrument and submit them to the Vice Chancellor, Human Resources.

A summary of the evaluations will be presented and discussed at a board retreat scheduled for that purpose. The results will be used to identify accomplishments in the past year and goals for the following year.
