Chapter 2 - Board of Trustees

BP 2725 BOARD MEMBER COMPENSATION

Members of the Board shall adopt a resolution which stipulates the compensation and benefits that current and former members of the Board shall receive. This resolution shall remain in effect until changed by subsequent action of the Board.

A member of the Board who does not attend all meetings held by the Board in any month shall receive, as compensation, the monthly amount divided by the number of meetings held and multiplied by the number of meetings actually attended.

A member of the Board may be paid for a meeting when absent if the Board by resolution duly adopted and included in its minutes, finds that at the time of the meeting the member is performing services outside the meeting for the community college district, is ill, on jury duty, or the absence is due to a hardship deemed acceptable by the Board. The compensation shall be a charge against the funds of the District.

Chancellor will direct staff to provide necessary secretarial services for all trustees to conduct District business as they deem necessary. The business of the District shall be defined as any correspondence written or electronic to promote the goodwill of the District (within the constraints of Proposition 73) or in response to any inquiry received by any trustee.
