Dear Ms. Janak:

As you know, in 2011-12 San Diego City College, Mesa College, and Miramar College limited concurrent high school enrollment to students enrolled in special partnership programs with San Diego Unified School District, due to reduction in funding for enrollment from the state.

I am writing to advise the counselors and other appropriate staff that this restriction will continue for the 2012-13 academic year, as we face another reduction in funding for enrollment. This difficult decision is part of our enrollment management plan to ensure that recent high school graduates have access to postsecondary education. **However, as with last year, there will not be any change to the Accelerated College Program (ACP) classes held on the high school campuses.**

The special programs that will continue to permit concurrent enrollment are listed on the back of this letter. Note that there are restrictions as to the number of classes that concurrently enrolled high school students can register.

Please share this information with counselors so that students can plan accordingly. Thank you for your support as we struggle with ongoing fiscal challenges.
