Dear Student:

Welcome to the Spring 2013 semester! Please pay close attention to the following important information to help you get off to a good start.

## Primary Term Class Deadlines: (Classes that meet January 28 – May 25, 2013)

- 1. The deadline to receive, process and pay for add codes is Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup>. Add codes are obtained from instructors.
- 2. The deadline to drop classes with <u>no</u> 'W' recorded is Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup>.
- The deadline to drop a class and be eligible for a <u>refund</u> of enrollment fees and/or non-resident tuition is Friday, February 8<sup>th</sup>.
- 4. The last day to withdraw from classes and receive a 'W' symbol is Friday, April 12<sup>th</sup>. Thereafter, students will receive a letter grade.

## Other Important Information:

- 1. Visit Reg-e at <u>https://studentweb.sdccd.edu/reg-e/</u> to add or drop classes, view and pay your fees, view your class schedule, purchase a parking permit, view your financial aid, or to purchase textbooks online.
- 2. Note that students waitlisted in a Chemistry co-requisite MUST be registered in their waitlisted class by the add deadline (February 8<sup>th</sup>) or they will be dropped from their other Chemistry class.
- Be advised that parking permits will be enforced beginning the <u>first day of the Spring semester</u>, January 28, 2013. Parking permits may be purchased online, or at the college Accounting Office on campus. Note that students are NOT permitted to park in staff/faculty lots at any time, with or without a permit. *Your CSID card is required when picking up a parking permit in the College Police Office.*
- 4. The campuses remain under construction; be sure to allow extra time to park and get to class.
