Get Assessed: Discovering your academic skills

Where do I Begin?

San Diego City, Mesa and Miramar Colleges offer free assessment tests for English & Math skills using a computerized assessment tool called Accuplacer. It's one of the key steps of the **Student Success and Support Program** to gain **priority** when you register for classes and helps take the guesswork out of choosing courses at the right level. You might find out that you are ready for higher-level courses in some areas, or need more preparation in other areas.

Be Prepared: Studying pays off

The assessment exam should be taken seriously. Placing into higher level courses will save you time and money. Ask a counselor about the **resources** available at each college:

Taking the Initiative: Advancement Exams or Refresher Courses

If you feel you are over-qualified for the course level you were placed in based on Accuplacer, contact the Admissions or Counseling Office to determine if you are eligible to take an Advancement (challenge) Exam and possibly qualify to enroll in the next higher level. Another option is to enroll in the appropriate Math 15 refresher course and if you are able to pass the final exam you are eligible to enroll in the next higher level. Questions?
