CHAPTER 6 – BUSINESS AND FINANCIAL SERVICES

BP 6305 Business and Financial

The Vice Chancellor of Business Services has global responsibility and authority for any and all matters related to the financial standing of the entire District, including, but not limited to, all division, department, program, and unit fiscal activity. Oversight and management of the District's financial standing is provided by the specific departments and sections within Business Services, including Internal Audit, Accounting, Accounts Payable, Asset and Inventory Services, Auxiliary Organizations, Budget, Grants & Contracts, Purchasing and Contracting, Records Management, and Special Funds. These units are authorized to oversee, govern, and regulate according to the appropriate statutory requirements, code provisions, the California Community College Business and Accounting Manual, District Policies, and Administrative Procedures.
