San Diego Community College District Civic Center Rates Fiscal Year 2019-2020

This rate schedule for the public use of District property was approved by the Board of Trustees.

The charge for use of a facility not listed below shall be established by the relevant site. Use fees are defined/determined as follows:

An application fee will be charged for all events.

<u>Non-Profit Cost*</u>: For activities or organizations qualified for non-profit use when the activities conducted or use of the facility creates an additional expense. (*Proof of non-profit status required.)

For Profit Cost: For activities or organizations which are not authorized for non-profit use.

Utility costs are included in the use charge unless specifically noted otherwise.

Custodial and Maintenance expenses: Salary rates for assigned employees are either the current actual salary rate or computed per the Salary Schedule Step 4 of the range x 1.5 rounded off to the nearest 25 cents. All other expenses are included in specific items in this schedule.

General SDCCD Staff Support: As requested or as needed: \$50.00/hour with a four-hour minimum. Additional labor rates will apply for events scheduled on a District holiday or holiday weekend.

The rates for the Hourglass Park facilities at Miramar College have a special use fee structure that is commensurate with the City of San Diego Park & Recreation Department rental fees. The rates reflect the joint purpose of the facilities, which were designed to serve the needs of both the San Diego Community College District and the community.

The minimum charge for the use of any District facility is four hours.
