## **Chapter 3 – GENERAL INSTITUTION**

## **BP 3540 - SEXUAL AND OTHER ASSAULTS ON CAMPUS**

Any sexual assault, physical abuse, or stalking as defined by California law, whether committed by an employee, student, or member of the public, that occurs on District property, in a District system, or at District-sponsored events or activities, is a violation of District policies and procedures. This conduct is subject to all applicable punishment, including criminal procedures and employee or student discipline procedures consistent with state and federal law. Students, faculty, and staff who may be victims of sexual assault, physical abuse, or stalking shall be treated with dignity and provided comprehensive assistance.

In accordance with Administrative Procedure, *AP 3540*, *Sexual and Other Assaults on Campus*, and other applicable procedures, the San Diego Community College District ensures that students, faculty, and staff who are victims of sexual assault, physical abuse, or stalking, receive appropriate information and treatment, and that educational information about preventing sexual assault, physical abuse or stalking is provided and publicized, as required by law.

The procedures shall meet the criteria contained in Education Code Sections 67385, 67385.7, and 67386 and 34 Code of Federal Regulations Part 668.46.
