4840.1 - ACCIDENTS, EMPLOYEE LIABILITY AND RESPONSIBILITY

REGULATIONS

- 1. The District liability insurance policy protects all District officers and employees from liability incurred while performing their official duties.
- 2. Every attempt should be made to avoid actions that might result in litigation, but if there is such an action immediate information to the proper personnel is mandatory.
- 3. Scope of Employment--Generally, anything done by an employee when acting within the confines of his/her job duties. An exact statement of what constitutes such action and scope may require court interpretation.

IMPLEMENTATION

- 1. Accident Reporting
 - a. Employee
 - 1) Informs his/her supervisor of all actions which might result in litigation.
 - 2) Secures form from site Business Office, completes and returns.
 - b. Administrator--Signs report; forwards three copies to General Services Business Office within 24 hours; files fourth copy.
 - c. General Services Office
 - 1) Forwards original accident report to insurance carrier immediately.
 - 2) Confers with insurance carrier and department head or president as required.
 - 3) Notifies legal counsel if a legal problem arises.
- 2. Investigation of School Accidents by Insurance Company

- Insurance Adjuster--Should produce a letter of introduction or other proper identification from the company, in order to secure cooperation of District officials.
- b. If Adjuster Makes Contact by Phone:
 - 1) District official obtains adjuster's name and offers to call him/her back.
 - 2) District official calls office of insurance company, asking for adjuster by name; may cooperate fully in giving information.
- 3. Legal Papers Served Against Employees or Students--see Administrative Procedure 2000.
