

# STATEWIDE TRENDS IN COMMUNITY COLLEGE FTES

- Community college FTES increased statewide between 2012-2013 and 2015-2016 with a decline in 2016-2017.
- ▶ SDCCD FTES increased at a proportionally higher rate than statewide FTES (11% compared to 5%); the District continued to experience growth in 2016-2017 as statewide FTES declined.

## STATEWIDE TRENDS IN COMMUNITY COLLEGE ENROLLMENT


- Currently, there are 31 districts that did not meet their base FTES in the current year (in stability).
- There are 29 districts in stability restoration, meaning they are growing back their FTES level.
- Overall, 21 districts experienced growth as of P1, nine of which are in stability restoration.
  - SDCCD is currently one of 12 growth districts statewide.

### REGIONAL TRENDS IN COMMUNITY COLLEGE ENROLLMENT


- There are four districts in the region that are reported to be in stability this year.
- There is one district in stability restoration.
- SDCCD is the only district in the region projected to have enrollment growth this year.


### SDCCD ENROLLMENT DASHBOARD


- From 2012-2013 to 2016-2017, the number of sections increased 38% and FTES increased 11%.
- Enrollments have steadily increased (+15%) in the same time period despite the shifting economy and declining unemployment rate.



### FIVE-YEAR FTES TREND DISTRICTWIDE

- FTES at the credit colleges is on track to increase 6% between 2013-2014 and 2017-2018.
- FTES at CE is on track to increase about 1% between 2013-2014 and 2017-2018.
- Overall, FTES is on track to increase 6% districtwide between 2013-2014 and 2017-2018.
- Largest FTES growth areas:
  - ▶ Online: +69%
  - ► Concurrent/Dual Enrollment: +66%
  - ► CTE: +11%

### 2017-2018 ENROLLMENT

- FTES is on target to grow almost 1% districtwide in 2017-2018 compared to 2016-2017.
- Miramar College is projected to reach 10,000 FTES as a result of an accelerated growth strategy that will move Miramar to a medium size college.
