


Student Success Scorecard Follow Up Report Five-Year Trend Analysis 2017

Background

- Intended to provide broad transparency and accountability.
- Provides measures of progress towards specific outcomes:
 - Completion Rate
 - Persistence Rate
 - 30+ Unit Completion Rate
 - Remedial Rate
 - Transfer Achievement in Math and English Rates
 - Career Technical Education (CTE) Completion Rate
 - Skills Builder Wage Increase
 - Career Development and College Preparation (CDCP) Rate
- Outcome measures are reported by:
 - Overall: Student attempted any level of Math or English in the first three years
 - <u>College Prepared</u>: Student's lowest course attempted in Math and/or English was college level
 - <u>Unprepared for College</u>: Student's lowest course attempted in Math and/or English was remedial level


Completion Rate - Overall



Five Year Trend for 'Overall' Students


- City showed a 17% decrease, Mesa showed a 6% decrease, Miramar showed a 2% decrease, while the State average showed a 1% decrease.
- Note that student completion over this time period was likely impacted by significant declines in community college budgets.

Completion Rate - Prepared




Five Year Trend for 'Prepared' Students

• City showed a 13% decrease, Mesa showed a 2% increase, and Miramar showed a 4% increase. There was no change Statewide.




Completion Rate - Unprepared

 change Statewide.


30 Unit Rate - Overall

 3% increase Statewide.


30 Unit Rate - Prepared

 5% increase Statewide.


30 Unit Rate - Unprepared



Five Year Trend for 'Unprepared' Students


City showed a 4%

Persistence Rate - Overall




Five Year Trend for 'Overall' Students

 6% increase Statewide.




Persistence Rate - Prepared




Five Year Trend for 'Prepared' Students

 Statewide.




Persistence Rate - Unprepared




Five Year Trend for 'Unprepared' Students

 5% increase Statewide.




Remedial Rate - English




Five Year Trend for "English" Students

 4% increase Statewide.




Remedial Rate - Math




Five Year Trend for "Math" Students

 4% increase Statewide.




Remedial Rate - ESL




Five Year Trend for "ESL" Students

 5% increase Statewide.




Transfer Achievement Rate - Math

 5% increase Statewide.


Transfer Achievement Rate - English



Five Year Trend for "English" Students


City showed a 16%

Career Technical Education (CTE) Rate



Skills Builder Wage Increase




Two Year Wage Trend

- City College Peer Group (13 Colleges)
 - City College had third lowest ratio (465:1)
 - Lake Tahoe Community College had lowest ratio (376:1)
 - Glendale Community College had highest ratio (1925:1)
- Mesa College Peer Group (19 Colleges)
 - Mesa College had seventh lowest ratio (572:1)
 - Santa Monica College had lowest ratio (306:1)
 - Diablo Valley College had highest ratio (1282:1)
- Miramar College Peer Group (11 Colleges)
 - Miramar College had fifth lowest ratio (532:1)
 - College of Marin had lowest ratio (257:1)
 - Foothill College had highest ratio (751:1)
