## Campus Support Services

- Designated International Student Advisor (City, Mesa, and Miramar)
- Two to three day mandatory orientation (City, Mesa, and Miramar)
- Online International Student Connection (Mesa)
- Recognition at Commencement: acknowledgement in President's remarks (City); special sashes worn with regalia (Mesa)
- Currently working on voluntary access to student medical insurance (District)

## **Admissions Process**

- The admission process typically takes three to five months due to Visa requirements
- Admission process begins with an abbreviated application for admission
  - Students pay a \$100 application processing fee that is applied to the nonresident tuition, once admitted
- Students must meet the following admission requirements:
  - High school diploma or equivalent
  - Submission of an English-translated transcript from all secondary and college/universities attended
  - Evidence of English Language competence: minimum score of 500 on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)



- Verification of sufficient financial resources
  - International students are not eligible for financial aid
  - International students many not be employed off campus unless special approval is granted by United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE)
- Health clearance
- Proof of medical insurance in United States
