
Background

- Intended to provide broad transparency and accountability.
- Provides measures of progress towards specific outcomes:
 - Completion Rate
 - Persistence Rate
 - 30+ Unit Completion Rate
 - Remedial Rate
 - Transfer Achievement in Math and English Rates
 - Career Technical Education (CTE) Completion Rate
 - Skills Builder Wage Increase
 - Career Development and College Preparation (CDCP) Rate
- Outcome measures are reported by:
 - Overall: Student attempted any level of Math or English in the first three years
 - <u>College Prepared</u>: Student's lowest course attempted in Math and/or English was college level
 - <u>Unprepared for College</u>: Student's lowest course attempted in Math and/or English was remedial level
 - Demographics: age, gender and ethnicity






Completion Rate



- Overall: City decreased 6%, Mesa increased by 3%, Miramar demonstrated no change, and statewide increased 1%.
- Prepared: City decreased by 2%, Mesa and Miramar increased by 6%. Statewide increased by 2%.
- Unprepared: City
 decreased 7%, Mesa
 increased by 3%,
 Miramar decreased by
 3%, and statewide
 increased by 1%.




30 Units Rate



- Overall: City increased 5%, Mesa increased by 3%, Miramar increased by 1%, and statewide increased 1%.
- **Prepared**: City increased by 1%, Mesa increased by 6%, Miramar demonstrated no change, and statewide increased 2%.
- Unprepared: City increased by 5%, Mesa increased by 1%, Miramar increased by 2%, and statewide increased 1%.




Persistence Rates

Remedial Rates




- Math: City increased by 1%, Mesa increased by 2%, Miramar decreased by 1%, and statewide increased 2%.

Average


Transfer Level Achievement

- English: City increased by 4%, Mesa increased by 5%, Miramar increased by 4%, and statewide increased by 2%.




Career Technical Education Rate






CDCP Rates
