

Remedial Rates




Statewide Average

Compared to 2015/16:

- Math: City increased by 1%, Mesa increased by 2%, Miramar increased by 3%, and statewide increased 3%.
- English: City increased
 4%, Mesa increased
 3%, Miramar increased
 1%, and statewide
 increased by 2%.
- ESL: City increased 11%, Mesa increased by 16%, Miramar increased 15%, and statewide increased 2%.

Compared to 2015/16:


- Math: City increased 2%, both Mesa and Miramar increased 3%, and statewide increased 1%.


Persistence Rates

- Unprepared: City increased 1%, both Mesa and Miramar increased 3%, and statewide increased 1%.


30 Units Rate





Median Inflation Adjusted Wage Increase Compared to 2015/16:





Five Year Trend for "English" Students


City showed an 8% increase, Mesa showed a 4% increase, and Miramar showed a 6% increase. There was a 5% increase Statewide.

Five Year Trend for "Math" Students


• City showed a 5% decrease, Mesa demonstrated no change, and Miramar showed a 2% decrease. There was a 6% increase Statewide.

 City showed a 20% increase, Mesa showed an 18% increase, and Miramar showed a 13% increase. There was a 6% increase Statewide.




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Transfer Achievement Rate - Math

• **City** showed a 6% increase, **Mesa** showed a 5% increase, and **Miramar** showed an 8% increase. There was a 5% increase **Statewide**.





Five Year Trend for 'Overall' Students






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Persistence Rate - Unprepared

Five Year Trend for 'Unprepared' Students



City showed an 11% increase, Mesa showed an 8% increase, and Miramar showed a 5% increase. There was a 3% increase Statewide.




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30 Unit Rate - Prepared

Five Year Trend for 'Prepared' Students


• **City** showed a 22% increase, **Mesa** showed an 11% increase, and **Miramar** showed a 12% increase. There was a 7% increase **Statewide**.



30 Unit Rate - Unprepared


Five Year Trend for 'Unprepared' Students







• Both **City** and **Mesa** demonstrated no change, and **Miramar** showed a 5% increase. There was a 5% increase **Statewide**.




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Skills Builder Wage Increase

Three Year Wage Trend


Both City and Mesa showed a 12% increase, while Miramar showed a 9% increase.
