State Authorization for Online Education

The United States Department of Education regulation 4 C.F.R. § 600.9(c) requires each state to apply for and receive authorization to provide online/distance education programs to out-of-state students. California has not signed onto any formal agreement with other states. Institutions must individually apply for and receive authorization to provide education online/distance education.

In order to maintain compliance, students residing in the following states/territories are not permitted to enroll in online classes and will be dropped:

- Alabama
- Alaska
- Arkansas
- Georgia
- Maryland
- Minnesota
- Missouri
- North Dakota
- South Carolina
- South Dakota
- Utah
- Wyoming
- Washington DC
- American Samoa
- Guam
- Marshall Islands
- Micronesia
- N. Mariana Islands
- Puerto Rico

If the mailing address needs to be corrected, or if a student has recently moved to California, they can log into <u>mySDCCD</u> and update their mailing address. Once the address has been updated to a California address or from a state where the District has received authorization, the student can enroll in online classes at SDCCD.
