#### TAILORED DAY

Independent social service agencies that provide Day Aides for both educational and vocational support.

- Approved/Funded by SDRC
- · Must apply for services individually
- Communicate and schedule based on services and needs
- Education support, Job Coaching, Community Integration
- Should work collaboratively with C2C to support overall DOR goals
