- 1. Bradley Fields, representative of the San Diego Community College Police Officers Association (POA), addressed the Board regarding salary surveys that Board members will be considering. He noted that the survey incorporated only salaries and asked the Board to consider the retirement packages of other statewide organizations, i.e., California Highway Patrol, UC and CSU systems, and other local agencies, which provide a "safety retirement" calculation of 3% at 50 for police officers. He also urged the Board to obtain and provide information regarding the total cost involved in recruitment and training of police officers and include that information as part of their decision-making process.
