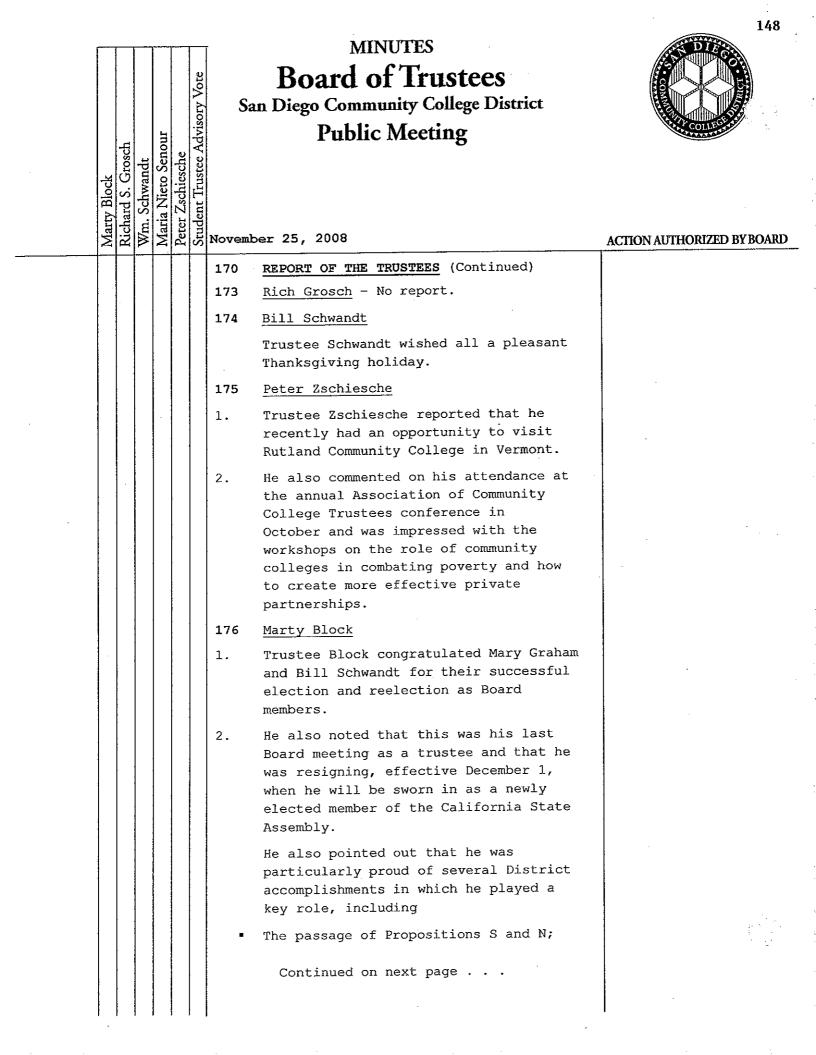

Current projections indicate that the budget deficit in the current year will exceed \$9 billion, with another downturn of over \$13 billion projected for 2009-2010. She noted that the Legislature was in a special session to address the financial emergency, as well as to make decisions based upon recommendations by the Governor and the Legislative Analyst's Office (LAO), including the need for new sources of revenue. Chancellor Carroll shared her report with Vice Chancellor Terry Davis, who provided details about the impact of the proposals by the Governor and LAO, as well as the need for the SDCOD to initiate a \$5 million budget reduction in the current year, while planning for further reductions next year. She added that the goals of preserving the educational mission and avoiding negative impact upon employees were still operative.

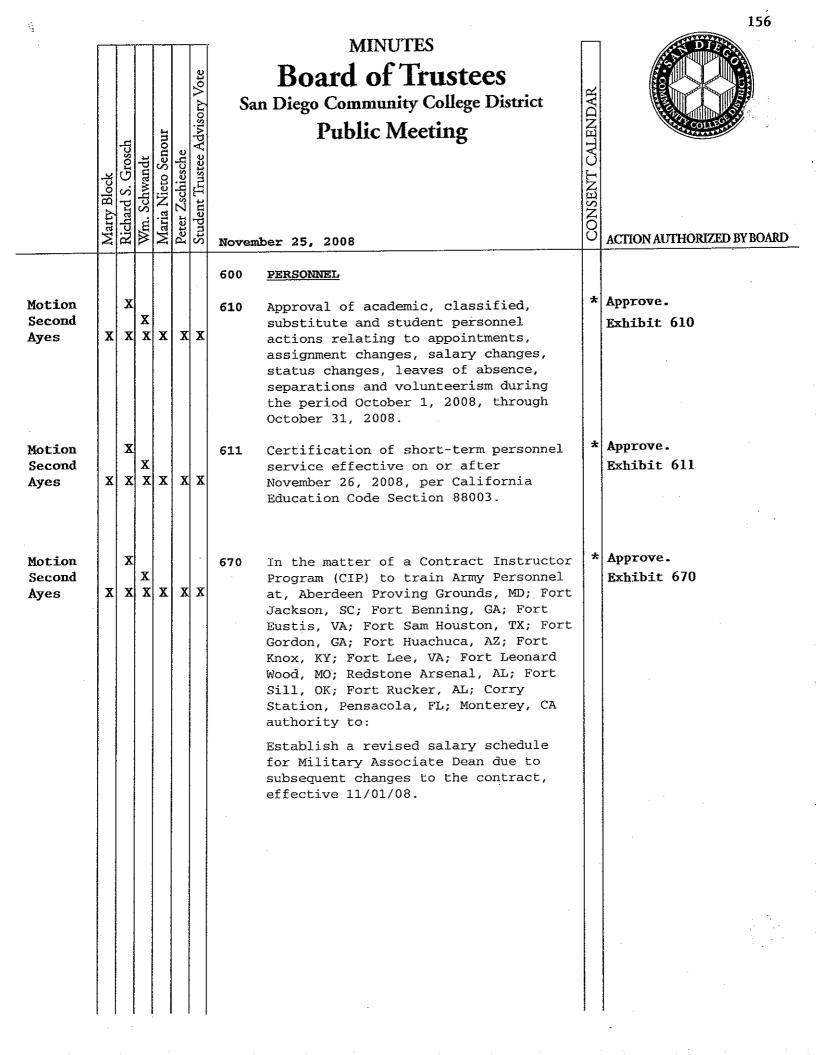
