400 BUDGET AND FINANCE

420 Authority to accept, budget and spend in the 2011-2012 General Fund/ Restricted Budget, an additional \$4,905 from the Superintendent of Schools, San Diego County Office of Education (SDCOE) to conduct Regional Occupational Program (ROP) related services during 2011-2012. The addition will increase the ROP restricted budget from \$65,000 to \$69,905.
