Board of Trustees Policy

Chapter 2 – Board of Trustees

BP 2015 STUDENT MEMBERSHIP(S)

The Board shall include one non-voting student member(s). The student member will be elected in accordance with Board Policy *BP 3200 Student Government and Organizations*.

The Associated Student Presidents of City, Mesa, and Miramar colleges shall have the responsibility of Student Trustee. Only one of the three shall sit with the Board on a rotation basis determined by the three Associated Student Presidents. The student member(s) shall have an advisory vote. Such member(s) shall have the right to attend each and all meetings of the Board, except that the student member(s) shall not have the right, nor be afforded the opportunity, to attend Closed Sessions.

The student member(s) shall be seated with the members of the Governing Board on a rotation basis as described above and shall be recognized as a full member of the Board at the meetings, including receiving all materials for public meetings presented to the Board members and participating in the questioning of witnesses and the discussion of issues and casting an advisory vote. The student member(s) are not entitled to make, amend, or second motions. The student member(s) shall have the right to remove items from the consent calendar for discussion.

The advisory vote of the student member shall not be included in determining the vote required to carry any measure before the Board.

The term of office of the student member(s) shall be one year commencing on June 1 of each year. The student member is required through the term of office to be enrolled in a college of the District for at least five semester units and to maintain a 2.0 grade point average for all college work attempted.

The student member(s) shall be authorized reimbursement for mileage by resolution in the same manner and to the same extent as other Board members. The student member(s) shall not be compensated as prescribed by Section 72024 of the California Education Code. Compensation for the student member(s) is outlined in the Student Trustee Handbook on file in the Vice Chancellor, Student Services Office.
