Board of Trustees Policy

Chapter 2 - Board of Trustees

BP 2105 ELECTION OF STUDENT MEMBER(S)

The students enrolled in each of the Community Colleges of the District shall in a general election elect an Associated Student Body President who will also serve as the Student Trustee. Elections shall be conducted in accordance with Student Services, Procedure 3200.1.

The student member(s) shall be chosen by the students enrolled at each college in the District as follows:

1. Any student who is: (a) a resident of California; and (b) enrolled in a college of the District for at least five semester units may stand for election by filing a declaration of candidacy at each college during the first week of April. The election shall be held at each college no later than the first week of May (first week is specified as the first week containing a Monday). Names shall appear on each ballot in alphabetical order.

The student member is required through the term of office to be enrolled in a college of the District for at least five semester units and to maintain a 2.0 grade point average for all college work attempted.

2. It is the Board's intent that the student member(s) represent the districtwide student position and toward that end the Chancellor shall prescribe a districtwide channel for communication involving student position input from all colleges/campuses. Administrative support for the provision of districtwide student input shall be determined annually as a part of the regular budget process.

3. A recall election may be activated in accordance with the recall procedures prescribed for the Associated Student Body elections at each college.

4. In the event that a student representative is unable to complete his/her term, the vacancy shall be filled by the remaining Associated Student Presidents at the other college(s).
