Chapter 6 – Business and Financial Services

BP 6900 – ENTERPRISE ACTIVITIES

The Board of Trustees has established the Enterprise Services department for the purposes of providing enterprise activities that are of general benefit to the students, staff, and faculty of the San Diego Community College District.

Enterprise Services administers the San Diego Community College District Food Services, Bookstore, Vending and other enterprise services. Enterprise fund activities, administered by the Enterprise Services department, are to operate in accordance with the California Community College Budget & Accounting Manual and are intended to be self-supporting. The total costs of providing goods and services on a continuing basis, include but are not limited to maintenance of operating capital, systems that provide for adequate management control and accountability and other District costs are to be financed or recovered primarily through user charges from these associated activities.
