CHAPTER 4—Instructional Services

BP 5400 COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAMS

The San Diego Community College District's Colleges and Continuing Education may maintain community service programs including, but not limited to the following courses: classes in civic, vocational literacy, health, technical education as well as classes in the fields of music, art, handicraft, science, literature, nature study, aquatic sports and athletics.

The community service programs shall be designed to contribute to the physical, mental, moral, economic or civic development of the individuals enrolled in it.

Community service courses shall be open for admission of individuals who can benefit from the programs.

No General Fund monies may be expended to establish or maintain community service courses. Students involved in community service courses shall be charged a fee not to exceed the cost of maintaining the courses. Courses may also be offered by remuneration by contract or with contributions or donations of individuals or groups.
