Ability to use cleaning materials and equipment efficiently, understand and follow oral and written directions, work cooperatively with others, maintain positive working relationships and interpersonal communication style, and perform moderate physical labor.

- Clean and disinfect lavatories, toilets, drinking fountains, and other plumbing fixtures.
- Wash windows.
- Dust, wax, and polish furniture and woodwork.
- Clean chalk/white boards.
- Operate a variety of hand tools and power equipment.
- Set up or move furniture and equipment.
- Empty and clean waste and recycling containers.
- Pick up and dispose of paper and other refuse.
- Scrub, sweep, and clear walkways and outside areas.
- Remove debris from storm drains, roofs, and gutters.
- Refill paper, soap, and other dispensers.
