# Why AI in Education?

## Research:

- In Fall of 2025, SDCCCD II&E conducted an AI survey to gain insight into how students view AI in their educational experience. A total of 7,601 students completed the survey.

## Findings:

- Students are actively using AI, both for school and personal tasks, with mixed but meaningful impacts on their learning.
- They want more AI education, noting gaps in the curriculum and a desire for formal training.
- Students see both benefits and risks, valuing AI's creative potential while worrying about ethics, transparency, and future jobs.
- They expect AI to shape most careers, even as many remain unsure about its role in education right now.
