Employee demographics, % of rooms by type, assessed property value, finances by funding source (e.g., General Fund, grant funds per college and total), among others.

## ➤ Student Data Points

Top 5 Majors, Fin Aid Headcount, FT/PT students, Success Rate, Completion Rate, 4 Year Transfers, Noncredit to Credit Transition, and Top 5 disciplines selected by prior SDCCE students

## ➤ Employee Data Points

Headcount by Ethnicity, Gender, and Employee Job Classification

## ➤ Institutional Data Points

Land Breakdown, Sq. Footage by building type, Room Type %, Prop Bond Projects, Bond Rating, Locally Assessed Property Values, Fiscal Expenditure breakdown, Grants received, and Financial Aid Disbursement amounts
