<p>~265C Employment Skills in Biotechnology 48 - 54 hours lecture, 48 - 54 hours lab, 4 units Grade Only</p> <p>REQUISITES: <i>Advisory:</i> Biology 109 with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent. This course integrates conceptual and technical biotechnology skills with interpersonal and communication skills essential for entry level employment in biotechnology. Emphasis is placed on literature and employment database searching, use of data analysis software, resume writing, interview techniques, seminar presentations, team building, independent learning, time management, collaboration, hands on experience in the field, and service learning. This course requires field trips to area biotechnology companies and research institutions. <p>259 Behavioral Science Statistics Laboratory 48 - 54 hours lab, 1 units Letter Grade or Pass/No Pass Option</p> <p>REQUISITES: <i>Corequisite:</i> Psychology 258. This laboratory course offers students practice in using statistical analysis software for the behavioral sciences. Emphasis is placed on data entry, graphing, hypothesis testing and statistical analyses.
