Subject: Biology (BIOL) Discipline: Biological Sciences

<p>205 General Microbiology</p> <p align="right">48 - 54 hours lecture, 96 - 108 hours lab, 5 units Grade Only</p> <p>REQUISITES: <i>Prerequisite:</i> Biology 107, Chemistry 100 and Chemistry 100L, each with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent or Chemistry 152 and Chemistry 152L, each with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent. This introductory course covers fundamental aspects of microbiology including taxonomy, structure, physiology, reproduction, genetics, control, immunology, diversity, and host-symbiont relationships. Lab work emphasizes basic techniques for culturing, staining, counting, and identifying microorganisms. <p>210 The Grammar of Spoken Italian I</p> <p align="right">48 - 54 hours lecture, 3 units Letter Grade or Pass/No Pass Option</p> <p>REQUISITES: <i>Prerequisite:</i> Italian 102 with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent. This course is designed to develop and enhance oral communication skills by means of reading, listening, and practicing Italian in various contexts. Topics include everyday life situations, current events, and culture. The course also includes grammar review, reading and discussion of contemporary literature, and written compositions. Subject: Nutrition (NUTR) Discipline: Nutritional Science/Dietetics

<p>91 Directed Clinical Practice</p> <p style="text-align: right;">150 - hours other, 2 units Grade Only</p> <p>REQUISITES: <i>Prerequisite:</i> Culinary Arts/Culinary Management 101, Nutrition 116, Nutrition 150, Nutrition 180, and Nutrition 199, each with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent. <i>Advisory:</i> English 47A or English 48 and English 49, each with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent or Assessment Skill Levels R5 and W5; Mathematics 38 with a grade of "C" or better, or equivalent or Assessment Skill Level M30. <i>Limitation on Enrollment:</i> This course is not open to students with previous credit for Nutrition 391. This directed clinical practice course applies previously learned knowledge and skills through supervised dietary services at a healthcare facility. The supervision of the student is shared by the college faculty and the staff of the affiliating institution.
