- 5. Boots requested discussion to review concerns pertaining to DRAM 114A and DRAM 114B. These courses read more like a how to course, and while drama faculty would like to support Mesa, these courses appear as more of a theater course and not a film production course.
- 6. Hoffman reported faculty have worked hard to rewrite the course description to avoid course duplication. Hoffman confirmed this is not a theater course and clarified students will be required to put together digital story telling (audition tape) with a device such as a smart phone.
- 7. Palma-Sanft suggested a workgroup to review the current walk-in course review process more efficient beginning with the fall 2022 term. Topham agreed and suggested reviewing the current process for opportunities to make the process more effective across the colleges. Odu would like to see a deeper collaboration between the College of Continuing Education and the credit colleges to align curriculum.
