The following curriculum changes are proposed for the San Diego Community College District for City College, Mesa College, Miramar College, or College of Continuing Education. There is no additional cost to the District.

New Programs

San Diego College of Continuing Education

1. Instructional Aid, Certificate of Completion

The Instructional Aide program will help students to understand the realities of working as an instructional aide, as well as help to promote job satisfaction and competence in an entry-level position by providing a general understanding of applied behavior analysis (ABA), individualized educational plan (IEP), and characteristics of disabilities in the school-aged child. Students will become familiar with teaching strategies, professional responsibilities, and laws and regulations related to teaching children with disabilities. Program instruction focuses on understanding terminology and applied practice through role-play.

Justification:

This program prepares students for entry-level positions that support learning and independence for individuals with disabilities across various settings including school, home, and community-based programs.

2. Introduction to Healthcare Careers, Certificate of Completion

This program provides an introductory overview of the healthcare industry, career opportunities; the basic knowledge required for entry-level positions in the healthcare profession and prepares students for academic and professional success by developing behaviors that support this outcome. Topics include business aspects of healthcare, delivery systems, services and specialties, regulations and mandates, workplace communication, safety issues, introduction to medical terminology, common diseases,



legal and ethical issues, professional conduct, career pathways, and employment readiness. Instruction includes skills to help students develop self-discipline, empathy, creating and leading self-managed teams. Course work focuses on personal responsibility through self-management, self-awareness, social and physical wellness while developing connections between behaviors, intentions, purpose, and the pathway to achieving goals.

Justification:

Upon successful completion of this program, students are prepared for entry-level positions such as Nurse Assistant, Dietary Aide, Laboratory Assistant, Laundry Aide, Occupational Therapy Aide, Orderly, Physical Therapy Aide, Rehabilitation Aide, and Transporter.
