







Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)






Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016–17)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)







Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)




Unique Headcount: # of Students Who Took 1+ Courses (2016–17)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)






of Students Who Earned Associate Degrees (2016–17)


% of Students Who Obtained a Job Closely Related to % of Students Who Attained a Living Wage (2014–15)






Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016–17)





Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)






% of Students Who Obtained a Job Closely Related to % of Students Who Attained a Living Wage (2014–15)




Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)


% of Students Who Obtained a Job Closely Related to % of Students Who Attained a Living Wage (2014–15)




Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016–17)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)




Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016–17)





Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)








Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)








Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)


Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)




Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)




Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)






Enrollment Trends






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)








Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)






Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016–17)




Course Retention Rate (2015-16)












Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)







Course Retention Rate (2015-16)








Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016–17)


Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)





Course Retention Rate (2015-16)






Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)


Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015–16)

Course Retention Rate (2015-16)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)










Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016–17)


Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)






Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)




Duplicated Headcount: # Course Enrollments (2016-17)





Course Retention Rate (2015-16)









Course Retention Rate (2015-16)




Course Success Rate (2015-16)



of Students Who Earned Associate Degrees (2016-17)








of Students Who Earned a Locally-Issued Certificate (2016-17)






San Diego City College

Completer and skills-building students at San Diego City College were surveyed if they met one of the following criteria in 2016-2017, and did not enroll (or were minimally enrolled) in 2017-2018: earned a certificate of 6 or more units, earned a vocational degree, or earned 9+ CTE units. The survey was administered in early 2019 by e-mail, text message (SMS), and telephone. The survey addressed student perceptions of their CTE program, employment outcomes, and how their coursework and training relate to their current career. A total of 1512 students were surveyed and 421 (28%) students responded: 40% by email, 54% by phone, and 6% by SMS.


How satisfied are students with the education and training they received?




How many hours per week are employed students working?



How many students secured a job that is closely related to their program of study?




How many months did it take for students to find a job?



What were the hourly wages of the students before training versus after training?




What were the hourly wages of transfer students and non-transfer students—before training versus after training?

More Key Results

\$10.00 is the overall change in hourly wages after completing training—in dollars

63% is the overall change in hourly wages after completing training—in percentage gain

84% of respondents reported being employed for pay

32% of respondents reported transferring to another college or university

90% of respondents reported being very satisfied or satisfied with their training.

Conclusion

The results of the survey showed that completing CTE studies and training – whether or not a credential is earned, whether or not a student transfers – is related to positive employment outcomes. The preponderance of respondents are employed and are working in the same field as their studies or training. Notably, students realize a greater wage gain after completing their studies if they secure a job that is similar to their program of study.
