Workplace Sexual Harassment Prevention (SB 1343) Mandatory Online Training

Frequently Asked Questions

San Diego City, Mesa, Miramar Colleges and the College of Continuing Education have partnered with Keenan SafeColleges to provide a mandatory online training to help Work Experience students understand and prevent sexual harassment in the workplace.

Is there a penalty if students do not complete the Keenan training?

The Keenan SafeColleges training is mandatory for Work Experience students enrolled in 270 and 272 courses and completion is required prior to starting Work Experience hours.

When do students need to turn in their Keenan training?

Students must complete the Keenan SafeColleges training prior to the designated Add/Drop deadline for each semester.

Do I need to send an email reminder to students to complete the Keenan training? If yes, is there a script to ask students to complete the training?

Keenan SafeColleges sends automated weekly email reminders to students until training is completed.
