

Miramar College Entrants from Service Area Feeder Schools

High School Pipeline Supplemental Worksheet, 2022-23

Entrants are students who enroll at City, Mesa, or Miramar Colleges in the year following high school graduation. The table below shows Entrants from **SDUSD Public** high schools.

Entrants are counted once per college at which they enroll in their first year of college, and once in the Total row. The sum of the college rows exceeds the Total row because students enroll at more than one college in the same academic year. The larger the difference between the sum of the college rows and the Total row, the more students enrolled at multiple colleges.

The Entrant Rate is the percent of seniors from that high school that enrolled at the indicated college. Sites with relatively high entrant rates are indicated with green cell highlights, and sites with low rates are indicated with red cell highlights.

Note that this table excludes entrants from high schools outside of the Miramar College Service Area who enrolled at Miramar College in their first year.
