Late Additions to CCAP Courses - Clarification of requirements and timeline

- Faculty require students to be "enrolled" by Friday of the first week (without faculty permission)
- Enrolled = on the faculty's class roster
 - This requires college enrollment to occur by no later than Friday morning
 - Requires SDUSD to provide updated report by no later than Friday morning
 - Requires SDUSD school sites to add new students into powerschool by no later than Thursday afternoon
- Any school site entries after Thursday will need to receive permission from the faculty
