

## SB-1348

### Postsecondary Education Allied Health Professional Clinical Programs Reporting Compliance

**2021-2022 academic year**

- All remaining programs must be inputted into the online system.
- There are no changes to the reporting process.
- **Reporting is due around week 6-8 of the semester or after students begin the placement (whichever comes first).**

**Impact(s) of COVID-19**

- If a clinical program does not have student placements for a semester due to COVID19, the program still must report (report zero). There are no changes to the reporting process.

**Background:** In September 2018, CA State Legislature passed SB-1348 requiring CCCCCO to report additional information on clinical placements within degree and certificate programs in allied health. Reporting requires the collection of clinical site license numbers (or EIN), the total number of students placed at each site, and the languages the placed students are proficient in other than English.

**Frequency** - Reporting occurs every semester (summer, fall, spring) and is completed by the institution directly to the state through the State’s [1348 Data Collection site](#).

- There is no access to upload data or import data into the system
- Reporting is due around week 6-8 of the semester or after students begin the placement (whichever comes first).

**Reporting Notes**

- Reporting is by clinical group by clinical site and requires the site license # or EIN. This information is collected as part of the districtwide clinical affiliations site agreement process and made available to all programs.
- Reporting should include only the student’s first site placement.
- Institutions are not required to report changes in placement.

**Tracking Template** - A template for preparing and tracking required information is available and has been distributed to all directed clinical practice programs. Institutions are encouraged to utilize this tracking template to support their online submissions.
